Empowering Future Leaders via DISTED's Leadership Day Camp



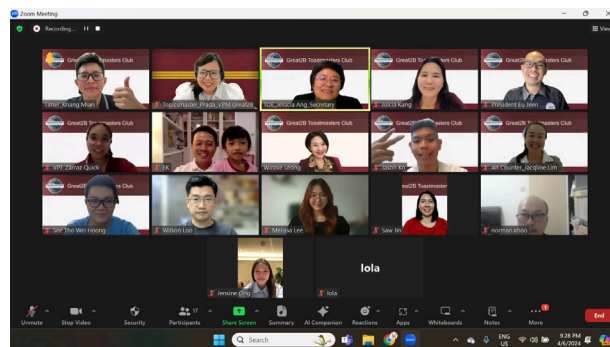
