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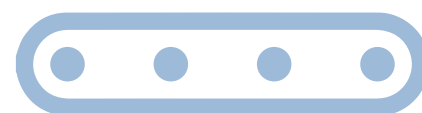

From Classroom to Production Line: Hands-On Learning Experience for Students

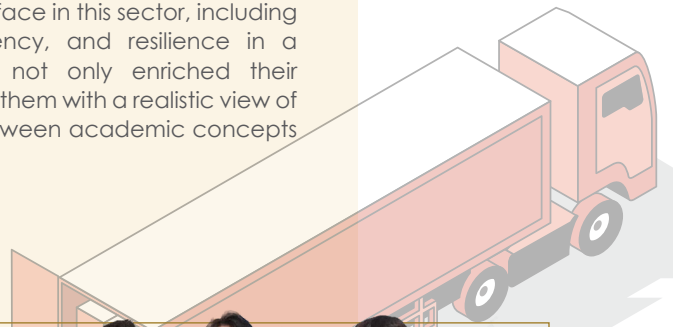
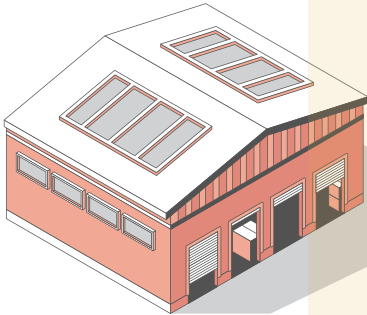

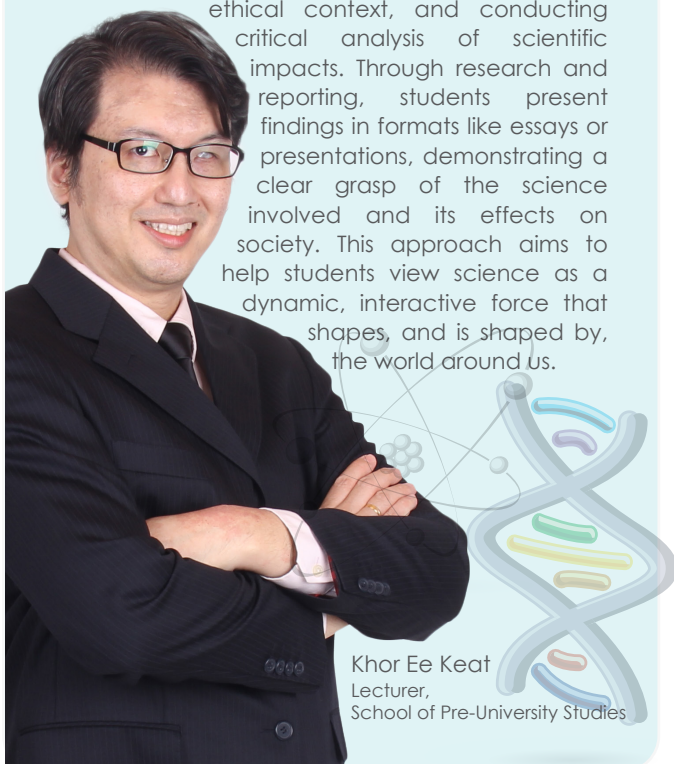
